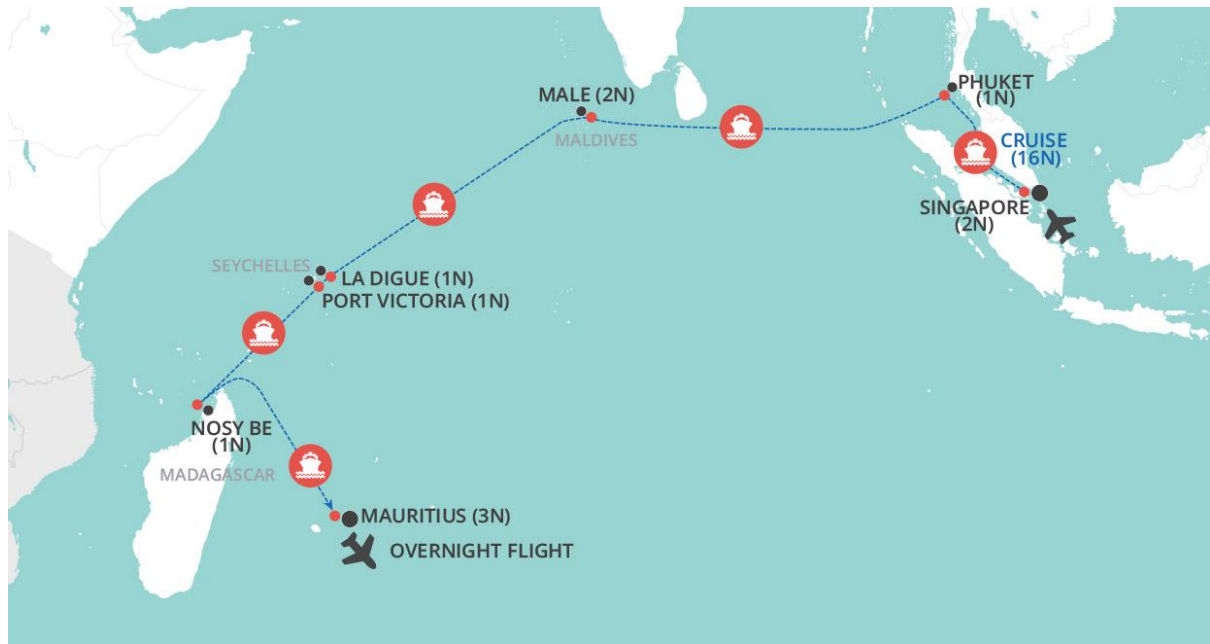

However, should you wish to dine in any of the speciality restaurants not included in your cruising / “more at sea” package, you will be required to pay for these locally. In addition, if you opt to dine off the ship, these meals will also be paid for

locally, and please note you will not be refunded for meals missed onboard. Excursions are also available to book with your cruise reservation at your own expense. Gratuities on board the ship are included in your tour cost.

JOINING YOUR TOUR:

The tour is 23 days in duration including international flights. Join the tour on Day 1 in Singapore and end the tour on Day 22 in Mauritius.

PHYSICAL LEVEL 1:

Our tours come with a physical rating to guide you in selecting a holiday that suits your comfort level. Joining any of our tours involves independent mobility and the ability to stay active throughout the day, which is essential for fully enjoying the unique charm of each destination.

'Indian Ocean Explorer' is rated as a **physical level 1** tour. A reasonable level of fitness is required, and you should expect to be on your feet for much of the day. You will be getting on and off coaches, trains or boats and walking around the sights, often including steps, plus occasional longer walks.

- There will be sightseeing on foot for both short and extended periods of time, often on uneven surfaces
- You will be required to get on and off small boats without assistance
- You will be required to board the cruise ship without assistance and get on and off at ports if you wish to disembark the ship

Of course, our National Escorts and local guides will always endeavour to provide the highest level of service and assistance; however, they cannot be expected to cater for customers who are unfit to complete the itinerary.

DETAILED ITINERARY**Day 1: Arrive in Singapore****Meals: D**

Fly to the vibrant city of Singapore. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport by your English speaking representative. Together with all other group members who may be arriving at a similar time, travel to your hotel and check in.

Please note: Early check-in is not included. If your flight arrives in the morning and you wish to arrange this, please speak to your reservation's consultant.

You will be transferred by shared coach with other passengers who are not part of a Wendy Wu Tour. If you are on a shared bus transfer, you may have to walk for a few minutes to get to your hotel. Transfers will differ depending on group size.

**Destination Information**

Singapore – This tiny republic sits just above the equator and the tip of the Malay peninsula. The trading port was put on the global map by Stamford Raffles, who negotiated the 1819 Treaty of Singapore, when the British East India Company opened up a trading port. Singapore passed through the hands of Britain, Japan and Malaysia before gaining full independence in 1965. Today, it has a highly developed economy and is ranked as a world leader in healthcare and education.

Day 2: Singapore**Meals: B, L, D**

After breakfast this morning, begin your full day city tour with a visit to Singapore's historic Chinatown, a bustling mix of old and new, filled with traditional shops and markets as well as a selection of stores and cafes.

Enjoy a stop at the Buddha Tooth Relic Temple and Museum, located in Chinatown before visiting the Kampong Glam, a historically rich and vibrant neighbourhood dating back to the 19th century. Here, you will also get to learn about the art of teh tarik or "pulling tea". Continue your tour with a visit to the Civic District, passing by the historic Parliament House and the National Gallery Singapore before arriving at the Merlion Park. Enjoy views of the Marina Bay before taking a stroll through the hidden underground walkway, once a vital tunnel used for transporting mail, now serving as a corridor for The Fullerton Hotel where you will enjoy an afternoon 'high' tea for lunch.



This evening, embark on a sunset river cruise up Singapore River before enjoying dinner at a local seafood restaurant. To conclude your evening, you will visit the colourful Gardens by the Bay. Explore the unique architecture before enjoying the impressive Gardens by the Bay Light Show.

Destination Information

Gardens by the Bay – This large public garden is famous for its Supertree Grove – vertical gardens built on tree-like sculptures up to 50 metres tall. Atop them sits the Sky Garden, accessible by elevated walkway.

Chinatown – Chinatown's maze of narrow roads includes Chinatown Food Street, with its restaurants serving traditional fare like Hainanese chicken rice, noodles and satay. Souvenir shops and indie boutiques dot the area, offering clothes, crafts and antiques, while Club Street is full of trendy wine bars.

Civic District – This area has a rich history dating back to the colonial era, serving as the administrative and political heart of the city-state. It was here the Singapore declared its independence in 1965.

Day 20: Mauritius**Meals: B, L, D**

And, last but not least, visit the popular Seven Coloured Earths and Chamarel Falls.

Black River Gorges National Park - A haven for nature lovers, Black River Gorges National Park is Mauritius' largest nature reserve. The park features dense forests, dramatic cliffs, and deep valleys, home to unique wildlife and endemic plant species. It's perfect for hiking, birdwatching, and enjoying breathtaking views of the island's rugged interior.

Chamarel Falls - is a stunning natural attraction with water cascading over 100 meters into a lush valley below. Surrounded by tropical greenery, the falls are a picturesque sight and a popular spot for photography and nature walks.

Seven Coloured Earths - is a unique natural phenomenon where the soil forms vibrant shades of red, brown, violet, blue, and green. This striking landscape, created by volcanic activity, is a popular attraction and a testament to the island's natural beauty.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

VISAS:

Singapore

A visa is not required for New Zealand passport holders for Singapore for stays up to 30 days. Your passport must be valid for at least six months from your date of entry, and proof of onward or return travel may be requested. Additionally, travellers may need to complete an SG Arrival Card electronically up to three days before arrival. <https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/sgarrivalcard/>

Thailand

A visa is not required for New Zealand passport holders for Thailand for stays up to 30 days. Your passport must be valid for at least six months from your date of entry, and you may need to provide proof of onward or return travel as well as sufficient funds for your stay.

Seychelles

No visa is required for New Zealand passport holders traveling to Seychelles, but you must obtain a travel authorization online before departure (There is a per person fee payable when completing the online form and this is not included). You can apply for this authorization up to 10 days before you arrive. On arrival, you will receive a visitor's permit valid for up to three months. To apply for travel authorization, ensure you have a valid return or onward ticket, proof of confirmed accommodation, and sufficient funds for the duration of your stay.

Madagascar

New Zealand passport holders can visit Madagascar for up to 15 days without a visa. Upon arrival, you must pay an administration fee per person (fee payable locally and not included) and provide proof of onward or return travel. Your passport must be valid for at least six months beyond your arrival date and have at least two blank pages.

Mauritius

New Zealand passport holders can stay in Mauritius visa-free for up to 90 days. A border official will stamp your passport on arrival to indicate the end date of your permitted stay. You must provide proof of onward or return travel and complete the "Mauritius All-in-One Travel Form" online before arrival, presenting the printed form with a QR code upon entry. Your passport must be valid for the duration of your stay and have at least one blank page.

Maldives

New Zealand passport holders will get a 30-day visa on arrival when you enter Maldives as a tourist. Your passport must be valid for at least 30 days after arrival and must not be damaged to avoid immigration issues. You are also required to complete a traveller declaration form (IMUGA) online within 96 hours prior to your arrival. <https://imuga.immigration.gov.mv/traveller>

INSURANCE:

It is a condition of booking with us that you take out suitable travel insurance. You must provide us with the name of your insurer, policy number and their 24-hour emergency contact number when you book with us or as soon as possible thereafter. These details will be available to your National Escorts should they be required. Wendy Wu Tours will not be liable for any costs incurred by you due to your failure to take out suitable travel insurance from the date of booking.

EATING

Cruise dining: Please note, there are no set menus onboard the cruise ship, instead, you will have the opportunity to dine at your choice of main restaurant included in your package and have the option to upgrade your package whilst onboard to dine in the various speciality restaurants. Your package also includes soft drinks and alcoholic beverages whilst onboard your cruise.

In Singapore: The city-state's cuisine is a reflection of Chinese, Malay, Indian, and Peranakan influences. Hawker centres serve as the heart of its food scene, where affordable yet iconic dishes like Hainanese chicken rice, laksa, satay, and chili crab delight locals and visitors alike. Fine dining is also prominent, with Michelin-starred restaurants offering innovative fusion creations. Whether indulging in street food or gourmet meals, Singapore promises a diverse and memorable dining experience.

In Mauritius: The local cuisine reflects the island's blend of Indian, African, Chinese, and French traditions. Staples include curries, biryani, and rougaille, alongside street food favourites like dhol puri and gateaux piments. Fresh seafood is central, with dishes like vindaie and bol renversé showcasing the island's creativity. Mauritius also boasts a thriving rum culture, with sugarcane-based rums complementing its culinary offerings. From bustling street markets to elegant beachside restaurants, dining in Mauritius is a celebration of flavour and culture.

PORTERAGE:

Please be aware that portering is not included on our tours in pre & post cruise. You will therefore need to be able to handle your own luggage within the hotel and when using transportation like trains and coaches.

Portering is included onboard the Norwegian Sun Cruise Ship. When embarking, your luggage will be delivered to your room from the check-in area at the port. When disembarking you will leave your luggage outside your cabin door on the last night of your cruise. Staff will then be able to make arrangements for your luggage, ready for disembarkation early next morning. Please also note, it is customary to tip for the portering service.

ACCOMMODATION:

All group tour hotels have private western bathroom facilities, TV, and a telephone. Electricity supplies can be erratic and quite often the power in hotel rooms is turned off while guests are out of the room. If you experience any difficulty, please speak to your Local Guide or National Escorts.

Your accommodation has been selected for convenience of location, comfort, or character, and can range from a business hotel in one city to a family-run guesthouse in a smaller town or a heritage-type hotel. Hotels are generally rated as local three to four-star standard but do please note that there is no international classification system for hotels and differences in facilities and quality do exist between the UK and other countries abroad. Rest assured that all hotels used by Wendy Wu Tours are regularly inspected by our staff and our partners to ensure that standards are met. Please be aware that there are security measures carried out at all hotels, on guests and vehicles entering the properties.

TRANSPORT:

Coaches: Coaches with air conditioning are used on our group tours for city sightseeing, short excursions to the countryside, and longer transfers where necessary. Roads in Singapore and Mauritius are generally well-maintained, but traffic congestion can be an issue, particularly during peak hours in Singapore and in urban areas of Mauritius. It may not always be possible to return to your hotel after sightseeing to freshen up before dinner, so some flexibility is advised. Timings for transfers and tours are approximations and can be affected by traffic or weather conditions.

Public transport: Singapore has a highly efficient and extensive public transport system, including buses and the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) system, which operates until late at night. It is an excellent option for tourists exploring the city. In Mauritius, public buses are available and affordable, but they are less frequent and may not cover all tourist areas conveniently. While functional, public transport in Mauritius might not meet the expectations of those accustomed to urban transit systems in developed cities.

Taxis: Taxis in Singapore are plentiful, metered, and can be hailed from the street, booked via apps, or found at designated taxi stands. They are a reliable and comfortable option, though they can be more expensive than public transport. In Mauritius, taxis are available in cities and near tourist hotspots, but fares are not always metered, so it is advisable to agree on a price before starting your journey. Taxi services in both destinations offer safe and convenient transportation for visitors.

CRUISE EMBARKATION & DISEMBARKATION:

Embarkation time is when you should arrive at the cruise terminal. Departure time is when your ship sets sail.

We strongly recommend guests complete their Online Check-In at least four days prior to sailing. Guests who have completed their Online Check-In should arrive at the terminal no later than one hour prior to the scheduled embarkation time printed on your cruise documents.

Please note: guests who have not filled out their Online Check-In must arrive at the port two hours prior.

Boarding Time in Ports of Call: In all ports of call, it is also the guest's responsibility to be back onboard the ship no later than one hour prior to the ship's scheduled departure time. Please be aware that shipboard time may differ from the time in the port of call and it is the guest's responsibility to follow the shipboard time. In the event a guest misses the ship, it will be the guest's responsibility to pay all expenses incurred to rejoin the ship.

APPROPRIATE DRESS:

When traveling to Singapore and Mauritius, as well as the surrounding Indian Ocean islands, it's essential to pack light, breathable clothing suitable for their tropical climates. Choose cotton or moisture-wicking materials in light colours to stay cool and comfortable. Long-sleeved shirts and trousers are helpful for protection from the sun and insects, especially during outdoor excursions. A lightweight waterproof jacket or poncho is also advisable, as brief but intense rain showers are common in Singapore and Mauritius.

For exploring Singapore's vibrant cityscape, casual yet modest attire is appropriate, particularly when visiting religious or cultural landmarks. In Mauritius and the nearby Indian Ocean islands, swimwear and light beachwear are essential for enjoying the stunning beaches but remember to cover up when leaving the beach areas. Comfortable walking shoes or sandals are a must for city tours, nature trails, or exploring the lush landscapes of Mauritius.

Protect yourself from the sun with a wide-brimmed hat, sunscreen, and sunglasses. Don't forget your camera to capture the beauty of Singapore's modern skyline and Mauritius' pristine shores, as well as the charm of nearby islands like the Seychelles or Maldives. Pack chargers and spare memory cards to ensure you don't miss a moment.

A small medical kit with basic first aid supplies and personal medications is recommended. Whether you're exploring bustling Singapore, relaxing on Mauritius' beaches, or hopping between Indian Ocean islands, you'll be ready for a memorable tropical adventure

Onboard dress code: On Norwegian Cruise, you can wear what you are comfortable with. Go cruise casual or get all-decked out and look your best – it's up to you.

WEATHER:

Singapore and Mauritius both enjoy tropical climates, ensuring warm, humid conditions year-round. Singapore's tropical rainforest climate features consistent temperatures of 25°C to 32°C, high humidity, and frequent short rain showers. Mauritius experiences two main seasons: a hot, humid summer from November to April with occasional tropical rain and a cooler, drier winter from May to October, offering milder conditions, especially on the central plateau.

As the cruise moves from Singapore to Mauritius via the Seychelles and Maldives, passengers will encounter tropical warmth, cooling ocean breezes, and calm seas. The Seychelles and Maldives boast idyllic beaches, clear waters, and abundant sunshine, with brief seasonal showers adding to their charm.

GROUP SIZE:

Most of our groups consist of 10 travellers or more and will be accompanied by a National Escorts. There will usually be no more than 28 travellers in each group although you may encounter other Wendy Wu tour groups while you are travelling.

All our departures are guaranteed to operate with a minimum of 10 travellers booked (unless cancelled due to factors beyond our control). National Escorts will accompany each group of 10 or more. However, at our discretion we may operate departures with a smaller group size as we try to operate advertised departures wherever it is viable to do so.

TIPPING / GRATUITIES

Pre & Post cruise:

Although tipping is not mandatory in Singapore or Mauritius it is highly welcomed and necessary for some workers to make a living, as the wages are often quite low within the hospitality and tourism sector. Tipping costs are not included in your tour and are a good way to show your appreciation for the service you receive, including to your local guides and drivers. We have included some tipping recommendations below:

Mauritius:

Recommended total tipping for tour \$15 Euros per person

Additional discretionary tipping information-

Bars & Restaurants: A 10% tip over the total amount of the bill is expected when no service charges have been included.

Porterage: EUR2-5 per piece of luggage

Singapore:

Recommended total tipping for tour \$5 SGD per person

On the cruise:

On board gratuities are included in your trip cost.

SOUVENIRS:

We want to be able to give you an opportunity to buy souvenirs, so we include some stops at museums or exhibitions which demonstrate a craft or product unique to that region with pieces available to buy. We understand that souvenir hunting is not for everyone, so we aim to take you to places, which hold local interest. We trust you will enjoy these opportunities to learn about local arts and crafts and understand their historical and cultural importance.

LUGGAGE:

All travellers are limited to two items of luggage each: a suitcase with a maximum weight of 20kg and one piece of hand luggage with a maximum weight of five kilograms. It is essential that your luggage is lockable.

On your cruise: While luggage allowance on your cruise may permit further capacity, we ask you to adhere to the above restrictions due to airline and touring allowances. Suitcases should be tagged, luggage tags can be downloaded and printed from your eDocs. For your convenience, we recommend that your luggage tags be placed on your bags prior to arrival at the port.

It may take a few hours after embarkation for your luggage to be delivered to your stateroom. Likewise, suitcases are collected on the last night of your cruise. To avoid any complications, be sure to bring a small bag such as a backpack for carrying any necessary medication, valuables, important documents and need-to-have items.

PERSONAL EXPENSES AND OPTIONAL TOURINGS:

Personal expense: You will need to take some extra money to cover drinks, laundry and souvenirs, plus any additional sightseeing that may be offered to you.

Optional tours: May be offered in each city you visit during your pre and post cruise tour. These are not included in the standard itinerary and will only be available if time permits and if seats are available.

Please ensure you have additional funds available if you feel you may wish to participate in any extra activities. Each option will be arranged locally by your National Escort/Local Guide, participation and tipping for optional excursions is completely at your discretion

Cruise Optional Excursions: Any optional excursions offered at each port will be at your own expense. You can book your shore excursions in advance or during your time onboard the cruise ship.

VACCINATIONS AND YOUR HEALTH:

We recommend that you contact either your doctor or Health centre for advice on vaccinations and travel health. Safetravel has a comprehensive website that you may also find useful www.safetravel.govt.nz

BEFORE YOU LEAVE:

We strongly recommend registering your travel plans with www.safetravel.govt.nz as in the event of an emergency, New Zealand Consular assistance will be more readily available.

Up until the day you travel, it is vital you keep up to date and familiarised with the entry requirements as these can change at short notice. You are personally responsible for completing any entry forms, conducting any covid tests (if necessary), etc and adhering to countries' specific entry requirements.

You can also access the New Zealand Government's travel advisory service for up-to-date information about your destination on the same website.

AFTER YOUR BOOKING:

Once you have booked with Wendy Wu Tours, you will receive an email with your confirmation invoice, along with a link to our website where you can find your visa information (if applicable) and other important information. Your final documentation pack will be sent to you approximately 2-3 weeks prior to departure.
